The 2nd edition of the International Conference on Applied Management Advances in the 21st Century was held virtually from 15 to 17 December 2021, due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

This conference was organized by the International Association for Development of the Information Society. The International Conference on Applied Management Advances in the 21st Century (AMA21) seeks to provide a unique forum for presentation and discussion of the last research developments and solutions for the current issues of the world economy. A global invitation was made to scholars, students, practitioners, organizations, government departments, policymakers and everyone interested in these subjects, to give their contribution.

These events 137 submissions from more than 24 countries. Out of the papers submitted, 23 got blind referee ratings that published them as Full and Regular papers, which meant that the acceptance rate was 17%. Some other submissions were published as Short and Concise papers, Reflection papers, and Posters/Demonstrations.
